
The Quick Release

Interested in Balloon Repair and Repair Stations?

Have you ever wanted to kn<mark>ow more about what it takes to be able to repair and maintain hot air b</mark>alloon equipment? Did you know that there are only half of the repair stations now as there were in the 1990s?

The BFA is offering a document that will explain how the process works and where to find the information needed to work through the process of becoming qualified and certified as a Hot Air Balloon Repair person. This is not a "how to" document, it is an introduction to what is required and how to navigate through the process.

Our goal is not to train you to become a repair person or to open a repair station; this is a document with links to the important information of requirements and guidance. The process is not an easy one and requires a lot of time reading and researching to discover the proper course of action to achieve your goal. Whether you want to become a repair person and/or open a repair station, the requirements are covered in 14CFR in parts 43, 65, and 145. This guide will help you sort through the regulations to find the parts that you need.

Our Mission is to stimulate interest in Hot Air Balloon maintenance and repair. This document will provide an easy-to-follow training guideline for achieving the FAA Repairman Certificate. The BFA recognizes the importance of balloon repair and proper training by providing a structured outline of that activity. We hope bring interest to those who wish to learn more about balloons and their continued airworthiness requirements. you all in Longview in June.




